The CCSS Psychology Easter Revision course is particularly well suited to students taking AQA (Advanced Subsidiary 5181 and/or Advanced level 6181). Other specifications can be accommodated, but need to be specified prior to booking a course.

The 2 ½ day AS and 2 ½ day A2 courses have been designed with the following aims

- To help students acquire a sound knowledge base in their chosen topics
- To explain how the exam papers get marked. This will involve working on knowledge and understanding (AO1) and analysis and evaluation (AO2)
- To look at past papers and improve student performance through written exercises and feedback
- To help students review their own methods of revising and create their own revision programme
- For A2 students, to understand what is meant by 'synoptic assessment'.
