Students come to CCSS with different backgrounds and abilities, but all of them benefit from the supportive approach at the college and achieve their potential.

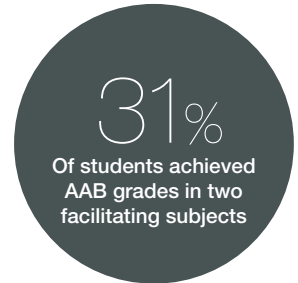
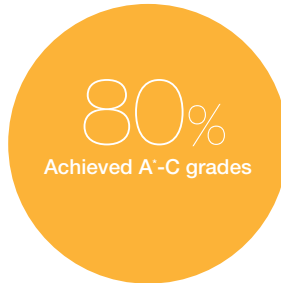
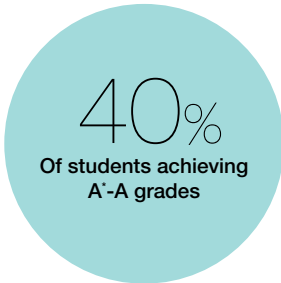


RESULTS AND DESTINATIONS

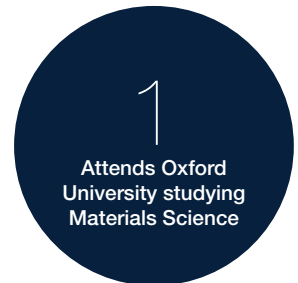
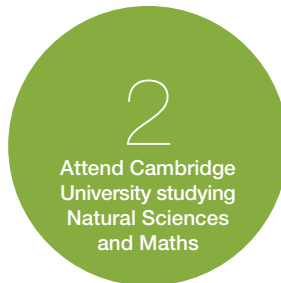
Up to 200 students from the UK and around the world come to CCSS every year to complete their secondary education before progressing onto university.

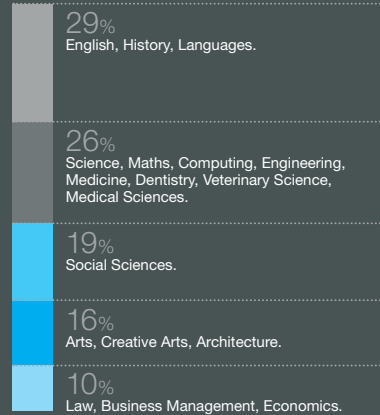
