#### **Description**

The job description cannot encompass all aspects of the job which requires a 'Duty of Care' for the students and a flexible approach to meet that requirement.

#### **About You:**

Experience of children and young people or of working in a schools would be great, but if you have a caring nature, like being around people and are willing to help out as needed with domestic tasks then this is a role you would enjoy.

As boarding staff provide 24/7 cover you need to be able to work shifts, including weekends, sleep-ins, and Bank Holidays during term-time.
